- 1. Short Introduction
- 2 Scales
- 3.Excerpt
- 4. Solo Material This segment could be 2 separate pieces, or 1 piece that demonstrates both lyrical and technical musical selections.

Students should dress respectfully- one step up from jeans is recommended.

No accompanists allowed for the solo portion.

Memorization of scales is required.

Memorization of solo is not required.
